Chairman Wells stated the first order of business was the certification of the results of the Statewide Democratic and Republican Primary Runoffs held on Tuesday, June 28, 2022.

A motion was made by Ms. McCall to certify the results of the Statewide Democratic Primary Runoffs, seconded by Ms. Day. The motion was approved by unanimous vote and the results were certified. A motion was made by Mr. Edler to certify the results of the Statewide Republican Primary Runoffs, seconded by Ms. McCall. The motion was approved by unanimous vote and the results were certified.

The next order of business was to order the mandatory recount for the Democratic State House District 101 Runoff in Berkeley, Florence, and Williamsburg Counties, to be conducted beginning at 3:15 p.m. Mr. Edler moved to order the recount. Ms. McCall seconded the motion. The motion was approved by unanimous vote and the recount was ordered.

A motion was made by Mr. Edler for a recess of the meeting while the recount of State House District 101 was conducted. Ms. Day seconded the motion. The motion was approved by unanimous vote.
